TEACHING PORTFOLIO

Summary

In my various roles within the University of Iceland I have been committed to develop the quality and innovation of higher education teaching, so that we can better meet the needs of our students as well as the Icelandic education system. I have led and/or initiated several important changes and development in the field of higher education teaching within the School of Education.

I have extensive teaching history with courses ranging from foundational subjects like "Introduction to Education" and "Ethics" to specialized topics such as "Leisure Studies and Leadership" and "Educational Innovation." I have also been involved in courses addressing research methods, academic writing, and well-being in education. I have extensive experience of thesis supervision, both at undergraduate and graduate level.

This portfolio provides overview of several innovation projects and information of my thesis supervision at both undergraduate and graduate level. Finally, this portfolio includes a list of courses that I have taught 2006 to 2023.

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Key projects and innovation

Accreditation and Recognition of Prior Learning in Pre-school Teacher Education.

(i. Raunfærnimat, since 2021)). As dean I implemented accreditation and recognition of prior learning in pre-school teacher education at SoE. This was developed in collaboration with the Division of Academic Affairs (i. Kennslusvið) and in partnership with stakeholders. This project has become a primary model for recognition of prior learning in other programs at the University level.

Strategic support for students with foreign language. I have worked with the Office of Academic Affairs at the SoE, as well as faculties at the SoE to set up strategic support for students with immigrant background. This has resulted in regular workshops for these students as well as academic counselling for them at the SoE.

Development of Higher Education Program for students with intellectual disability (2016-2017). I got Fulbright Funding to invite an expert from Syracuse University to conduct a review of our program for young people with intellectual disability. This project resulted in a report with suggestions to raise the quality of the program as well as setting up international partnership.

Academic mentoring for students (2016-2018). I received a 4.mkr grant from the University Teaching Fund (Kennslumálasjóður) to set up academic mentoring model in the faculty of social pedagogy, sports and health. This project led to increased awareness among faculity of student needs and challenges. Although the project did not receive funding for long-term implementations, certain aspects have been retained and become a part of good practice within the faculty.

On-site model in graduate programs at SoE (2014-15). I got a Fulbright Funding to provide external review on the organization of the teaching of our graduate programs and help us reflect on the quality of our programs. At that time, there were huge challenges with regards to transparency and coordination of how the hybrid teaching model at SoE was implemented. This project resulted in the implementation of two onsite modules in the graduate program at SoE.
